Maths – Learning Key Facts

A huge part of the new curriculum which came in in 2014 is that the children learn key facts and know them off by heart.

This may be number bonds to 10/20:

e.g $1 + 9 = 10$
 $2 + 8 = 10$
 $3 + 7 = 10$

Or if your child is in year 2 upwards it may be to learn their times tables off by heart.

e.g $2 \times 5 = 10$

The children need to know all their times tables by the end of Year 4. When you have the opportunity please help your child to learn them.

Reading Records

Please ensure that you are signing your child's reading record up to 5 x per week. The class teachers will be monitoring this regularly. It is essential that you hear your child read.

Christmas Jumper Day

On Friday 16th December the children can wear a Christmas jumper. If they do not have a Christmas jumper they can decorate their school Jumper to make it look Christmassy.
