Y5 / Y6 focussed support for under-achieving children (Closing the gap for target pupils)	£37,000	To achieve 100% of pupils making expected progress (2 levels) from KS 1 in Maths and English.
After school and holiday Y6 Booster classes for Writing and Maths	£4,500	For pupils achieving Level 2+ at KS1 to achieve combined L4 English and Maths
Paired / small group reading, writing and maths targeted intervention from Y1 - Y4 or Y5	£30,000	To enable pupils at risk of underachieving to reach age related expectations and to make accelerated progress.
ELKAN Training and Language groups programme (Nursery - Y3)	£2,700	To identify vulnerable pupils with speech and language needs and to provide small group language intervention programmes to 'close the gap' between them and their peers.
Additional learning resources to support learning of underachieving and vulnerable groups	£5,000	To enhance access to the curriculum of those pupils at risk of underachieving. To support the visual, auditory and kinaesthetic styles of learners. (ipads, Numicon, synthetic phonics, Mathletics)
Behavioural, Emotional and Social skills groups	£5,000	To enable pupils with BES needs to participate fully in their learning and achieve their potential To reduce the frequency of behavioural incidents which impact on the teaching and learning of individuals and groups of pupils
Fowler Newsam Hall Counselling Project (1 day per week)	£12,000	To support early identification and intervention counselling for pupils with emotional and social needs, to enable them to engage fully in their learning and make good progress
Attendance Monitoring Programme	£2, 000	To improve the attendance and punctuality of all pupils particularly those at risk of poor attendance impacting negatively on their attainment and progress.

Lunchtime and After School Clubs (Art , Film, Newspaper)	£ 2,000	To make provisions for engaging more able FSM pupils and accelerating their progress
After school sports clubs	£4,000	To improve the physical, emotional and social well-being of pupils and promote community cohesion
Spanish Club (Lunchtime)	£1,000	To provide oppo
English Club (EAL)	£2,000	To support pupils at the early stages of acquiring English as an additional language
Homework Club	£2,000	To provide support for vulnerable pupils who may not have access to learning support at home
Transition programme	£1,000	To enable vulnerable pupils in Year 6 to make safe transitions to secondary school through the provision of transition groups and support for families through all stages of the transition process.
Admissions and Inductions - Early Days Programme	£1,000	To support the induction of new pupils to school and ensure they are appropriately assessed and levelled for effective group inclusion.
Lunchtime Play Programme	£1,000	To support social skills development of pupils
Extra -curricular visits and school trips - day and residential (Subsidy for FSM pupils)	£2,000	To extend pupils experience beyond home and school.
1:1 tuition	£5,000	To provide intensive 'catch up' programmes for underachieving individuals
Music and Drama workshops	£ 15,000	To provide opportunities to develop and nurture the creative and expressive skills of pupils
SAFs mentor	£ 20,000	To support the developmental needs of pupils and families both within school and in the wider community
